NOTE:

These supplies will be required sometime throughout the school year. Some supplies (pens/pencils) should be kept at home and brought to school as needed. Classroom teachers may also request occasional special supplies during the year (poster board, band folders, art supplies). **Students will be expected to provide these items.**

PHYS ED

Phys Ed shorts with a minimum 4" inseam, or athletic/workout pants, t-shirt and indoor runners (must have non-marking soles). Short shorts, spandex and leggings are not acceptable. Gym runners must not be used outdoors. No platform runners/shoes, sandals or skate shoes are allowed in Phys Ed. Students are only to use non-aerosol deodorant (no spray).

DRAFTING

A geometry compass with capability to lock in place with adjustable screws. Drafting kits are provided for students' use. A payment in the amount of \$11.00 representing the fee levied for consumables in the kit is required. A permission click will be sent via email prior to the start of the school year to collect this payment.

DIGITAL PICTURES

A suitable digital camera (not a phone) is needed in which you can change preset scene modes or where the aperture and shutter speed can be adjusted manually. Memory card and a memory card reader is also required.

ALL SCIENCES

Closed toe shoes must be worn for science labs. If contacts are worn, eye glasses must be available to wear underneath goggles during chemical lab experiments.

ART

Students taking Art courses are required to supply the following basic items.

- 5 - HB pencils
- 1 set - 12 pencil crayons, high quality such as Prang, Laurentien, or Prismacolor
- 1 each – dual hole metal pencil sharpener, white vinyl eraser, gum eraser, kneaded eraser
- 1 each - 2B, 4B, 6B and 2H drawing pencils
- 1 - coil bound 9 x 12 sketchbook with at least 50 pages

DRAMA

Students in Drama will need a duo-tang or small binder with 30 sheets of loose-leaf. During the year, a fee for attending a live theatre performance and the Manitoba Youth Drama Festival may be collected.

CHOIR STUDENTS

New choir students (including all gr. 9 students) will be required to purchase a professional choir folder. The cost associated with purchasing this item will be sent out via permission click in September. All Choral students will need to bring a pencil and loose leaf to their classes.

BAND/CHOIR

All Grade 9-12 performing groups are required to wear black dress pants (no jeans, cords, yoga pants or tights), black socks and black closed toe dress shoes (no runners) for concerts. Following is a list of the tops each group will be wearing:

- **Grade 9-12 Band/Choir/Jazz Band and Vocal Ensemble**

Green button-up dress shirts with LCS music logo and gold tie. The costs associated with purchasing these items will be communicated via permission click at the beginning of the September. ***Gently used LCS dress shirts will be available for sale from PAPA in early September in the main school lobby. Further details to follow.***

- **Gr. 11/12 Vocal Jazz**

Girls: a solid black dress;

Boys: solid black button-up shirt with black buttons.

TEXTBOOKS

Textbooks are assigned to students in each course as required, at which time the condition of the textbooks will be recorded. The textbooks are to be kept at school in the student lockers (unless required for classes and homework) and it will be the student's responsibility to care for these textbooks and have them available for class. **STUDENTS WILL BE BILLED FOR LOST OR DAMAGED TEXTBOOKS AND/OR SCHOOL EQUIPMENT/PROPERTY.**

LOCKS AND LOCKERS

Only locks provided by LCS may be used. New students and returning students entering grade 7 are issued locks that will stay with them until they leave LCS. This includes taking their lock home for safekeeping over the summer break and bringing it back on the first day of school. A record of each student's locker number and lock combination will be kept in the Main Office. Students are not permitted to trade lockers or locks with another student. If a student has difficulty with their lock, they need report the problem to the Main Office so a replacement can be issued. There is a \$10.00 fee levied for lost or damaged locks.





Purchasing Device Specifications for Grade 5-11 Students at LCS for September 2018

Laptop

- screen no larger than 14 inch (to fit desk space and provide better battery life)
- 4GB RAM
- Laptop: 250GB Hard Drive
- Windows OS minimum Windows 10

Chromebook:

- screen no larger than 14 inch (to fit desk space and provide better battery life)
- 2GB RAM
- 16 GB internal storage

Tablet devices (Android or iPad) are highly discouraged due to:

- Connectivity issues
- Keyboard connections
- Size
- Difficulty for students using applications

Important Notes

1. Chromebooks are highly recommended as the first choice for devices at LCS as they balance price and best educational use.

3. Google Management software (included in the price offered by LCS) will be installed on all Chromebooks **purchased through LCS**.
4. Google Management software is highly recommended and can be purchased through the school for \$35 for other Chromebooks purchased outside of school.
5. Linden recommends purchasing monitoring software. An option that is compatible with all device OS is [Accountable2You](#).
6. For devices not purchased through LCS, it is recommended that you purchase an over-the-counter extended warranty. LCS is not able to support the servicing or repair of devices not purchased through the school.
7. Windows RT and Linux based devices are not supported.
8. Protective cases are highly recommended.

Grade 11 and 12 Considerations for University and College

Specific universities and colleges, and faculties within each, sometimes have recommendations on hardware and software. These recommendations vary widely. If you have a specific university or faculty in mind, please visit their websites to see those recommendations.
