REFUGE OF HOPE SCHOOL, VIEJA LIBERACION, DOMINICAN REPUBLIC

Five years ago, Ambassadors for Christ Canada embraced the vision of the Refuge of Hope School to provide education for children living in desperate need in a slum in Vieja Liberacion in the Dominican Republic. Through the gracious support of many people, the school building was completed in December 2011.
