



## 2018-2019 School Supply List - GRADES 7

**Students are expected to purchase their own supplies as follows:**

- ❑ NIV Bible (New International Version, Old & New Testament) to be left at school
- ❑ 1 school bag/backpack (regular size only, no large sport bags)
- ❑ Internet accessible device (see next page)
- ❑ Headphones compatible with device
- ❑ Pencil case
- ❑ Geometry set with a compass that has capability to lock in place with adjustable screws. (label each piece).
- ❑ Standard scientific calculator (label)
- ❑ Pens (blue/red/black) – 24 (bring 1-2 of each)
- ❑ 4 pkgs. of pencils
- ❑ Pencil crayons (24/pkg)
- ❑ Pencil sharpener
- ❑ Erasers – several
- ❑ 30 cm ruler
- ❑ 1 – 3” binder (zippered binder recommended)
- ❑ Loose-leaf paper (approx. 400 sheets)
- ❑ 1 coil notebook
- ❑ 1 pkg of centimeter graph paper
- ❑ 4 boxes of tissue (2 to homeroom teacher, 1 to French classroom and 1 to the Art classroom)
- ❑ 1 pkg of dividers
- ❑ 1 pkg of lined index cards
- ❑ Reinforcements
- ❑ 4-6 highlighters
- ❑ Recommend: water bottle to bring to classes

**Art**

- ❑ 1 coil bound 9 x 12 sketchbook (about 50 pages), white paper (not a scrapbook) [student may use last year’s if still has room] (label)
- ❑ 6 HB pencils
- ❑ 1 white vinyl eraser
- ❑ 1 metal pencil sharpener

**Physical Education**

- ❑ 1 small gym bag (cloth, drawstring bag preferred) including:
  - Phys. Ed. shorts with a minimum 4” inseam or athletic/workout pants. Short shorts, spandex and leggings are not acceptable.
  - T-shirt
  - Indoor runners (must have non-marking soles) to be left at school. Gym runners must not be used outdoors. No platform runners/shoes, sandals or skate shoes are allowed in Phys. Ed.
  - Non-aerosol deodorant (no spray).
  - Hair elastics for hair to be tied back.

**Grade 7 Band/Choir**

- ❑ “LCS Music” polo shirt to be purchased from school in September (approx. \$30)
- ❑ Black dress pants (no jeans)
- ❑ Black socks
- ❑ Black shoes (no runners)
- ❑ Gr. 7 - Essential Elements 2000 Book 2 (for your specific instrument)
- ❑ Black 1 inch 3 ring binder
- ❑ 1 pkg of dividers

**Note: Band instruments and method books should be labelled with first and last names, but NOT be brought to school until after your child’s first band class.**

**New students and those entering grade 7 will receive a lock from the school on their first day. Only locks provided by the school are to be used.**

**Label all supplies with student’s name.**





## Purchasing Device Specifications for Grade 5-11 Students at LCS for September 2018

### Laptop

- screen no larger than 14 inch (to fit desk space and provide better battery life)
- 4GB RAM
- Laptop: 250GB Hard Drive
- Windows OS minimum Windows 10

### Chromebook:

- screen no larger than 14 inch (to fit desk space and provide better battery life)
- 2GB RAM
- 16 GB internal storage

### Tablet devices (Android or iPad) are highly discouraged due to:

- Connectivity issues
- Keyboard connections
- Size
- Difficulty for students using applications

### Important Notes

1. Chromebooks are highly recommended as the first choice for devices at LCS as they balance price and best educational use.

3. Google Management software (included in the price offered by LCS) will be installed on all Chromebooks **purchased through LCS**.
4. Google Management software is highly recommended and can be purchased through the school for \$35 for other Chromebooks purchased outside of school.
5. Linden recommends purchasing monitoring software. An option that is compatible with all device OS is [Accountable2You](#).
6. For devices not purchased through LCS, it is recommended that you purchase an over-the-counter extended warranty. LCS is not able to support the servicing or repair of devices not purchased through the school.
7. Windows RT and Linux based devices are not supported.
8. Protective cases are highly recommended.

### Grade 11 and 12 Considerations for University and College

Specific universities and colleges, and faculties within each, sometimes have recommendations on hardware and software. These recommendations vary widely. If you have a specific university or faculty in mind, please visit their websites to see those recommendations.
