2022-2023 Tuition and Fee Schedule (International Students)

Acceptance of international/or non-resident students is limited and is based on the school's capacity to provide an effective English as an Additional Language (EAL) program.

Annual tuition fees for international students for the 2022-2023 school year are listed below.

Grade	Tuition per Student
Grades 1 - 12	\$13,000

Enrolment/Re-enrolment Fee

There is an enrolment/re-enrolment fee of \$50 per student.

Capital Fee

A Capital Fee of \$350 per family per year is collected to cover technology, infrastructure, equipment purchases, etc. Government support grants for the cost of educating students contributes to operational costs only. The Capital fee of \$350 is fully eligible for a charitable receipt.

Charitable Gift Receipting for Portion of Tuition Fees

A portion of tuition fees at Linden Christian School is considered to be a charitable gift. This amount, which has ranged from 46% to 51% of tuition fees in previous years, is eligible for a charitable receipt in accordance with Canada Revenue Agency guidelines.

Withdrawal and Refunds

Any changes in international or non-resident status during the course of the school year in which the student has currently registered, will not affect the tuition rate due as outlined in the tuition invoice. Any change from international to resident status will be accepted up until June 30.

Notification of intent to withdraw must be made in writing to the Admissions Office. One full month's notice is required. Refunds are to be considered as follows:

- One-half ($\frac{1}{2}$) of the full tuition fee if the student withdraws prior to September 30th.
- No refund will be granted, for whatever reason, if the student withdraws on or after October 1st.
