



## 2022-2023 School Supply List GRADES 9-12

### Students are expected to supply the following items and replenish as needed:

- NIV Bible (Old & New Testament)
- Internet accessible device - [Minimum requirements can be found here](#)
- Standard Scientific Calculator (Gr. 9 Math, Gr. 10-12 Essential Math, Gr. 12 Precalculus and all Sciences).

**OR**

T1-83/84 Plus graphing calculator (Required for Gr. 11-12 Applied Math, Recommended as well for the Gr. 12 Pre-Calculus class)

- Geometry Set with compass and protractor
- 8x11 Notebook/scribbler for Gr. 10 ELA
- Binders
- Loose-leaf paper
- Graph Paper (approx 40 sheets)
- Subject Dividers
- Pencil Case
- Pens (blue/red/black)
- Pencils
- Pencil Sharpener
- Eraser
- Pencil Crayons (12 pkg)
- Ruler with metric (cm, mm) and imperial (in) markings
- Glue Stick
- Highlighters
- Kleenex boxes (2) - given to teacher on first day for classroom use
- Water bottle

These supplies will be required sometime throughout the school year. Supplies such as extra pens, pencils, etc. should be kept at home and brought to school as needed. Teachers may also request occasional supplies during the year (poster board, folders, art supplies, etc.). **Students will be expected to provide these items.**

### Physical Education

- 1 small gym bag
  - Phys. Ed. shorts with a minimum 4" inseam or athletic/workout pants. Short shorts, volleyball shorts or spandex are not acceptable.
  - T-shirt
  - Indoor runners (must have non-marking soles) Indoor runners must not be used outdoors. No platform runners/shoes, sandals or skate shoes are allowed in Phys. Ed.
  - Non-aerosol deodorant (no spray).
  - Hair elastics for hair to be tied back.
- Fitness Academy participants will require their own pair of workout gloves.

### Locks and Lockers\*

Only locks provided by LCS may be used. New students and returning students entering grade 7 are issued locks that will stay with them until they leave LCS. This includes taking their lock home for safekeeping over the summer break and bringing it back on the first day of school. A record of each student's locker number and lock combination will be kept in the Main Office. Students are not permitted to trade lockers or locks with another student. If a student has difficulty with their lock, they need to report the problem to the Main Office so a replacement can be issued. There is a \$10.00 fee levied for lost or damaged locks.

**Labelling of supplies with the student's name is strongly encouraged.**

## **DRAFTING**

A geometry compass with the capability to lock in place with adjustable screws. Drafting kits are provided for students' use, however, they do not include the geometry compass. A payment in the amount of \$11.00 representing the fee levied for consumables in the kit is required. This will be sent out via Permission Click in September.

## **DIGITAL PICTURES**

A suitable digital camera (not a phone) is recommended in which you can change preset scene modes or where the aperture and shutter speed can be adjusted manually.

## **ALL SCIENCES**

Closed-footed shoes must be worn for science labs. If contacts are worn, eyeglasses must be available to wear underneath goggles during chemical lab experiments. A hair tie/elastic for long hair. Grade 11 - 12 Apple devices without a USB - B powered port need an adapter for electronic data gathering probeware.

## **ART**

Students taking Art courses are required to supply the following basic items.

- 5 - HB pencils (not mechanical)
- 1 set - 12 pencil crayons, high quality such as Crayola, Staedtler or Prismacolor
- 1 each – dual hole metal pencil sharpener, white vinyl eraser, gum eraser, kneaded eraser
- 1 each - 2B, 4B, 6B and 2H drawing pencils
- 1 - coil bound 9 x 12 sketchbook with at least 50 pages

## **DRAMA**

Students in Drama will need a duo-tang with 30 sheets of loose-leaf. During the year, fees for attending a live theatre performance, the Manitoba Youth Drama Festival and the Winnipeg Improv Festival may be collected.

## **CHOIR STUDENTS**

New choir students (including all Gr. 9 students) will be required to purchase a professional choir folder. Collection of payment for this will be sent out via Permission Click in September. All Choral students will need to ensure that there is a pencil and loose leaf in their folder at all times.

## **BAND/CHOIR**

All Grade 9-12 performing groups are required to wear black dress pants (no skirts, jeans, cords, yoga pants or tights), black socks and black closed-toe dress shoes (no runners) for concerts. Following is a list of the tops each group will be wearing:

- **Grade 9-12 Band/Choir/Jazz Band**

Green button-up dress shirts with LCS music logo and gold tie. Payment for these items will be collected via Permission Click in early September if they are needed.

- **Grade 9/10 Vocal Ensemble/Grade 11/12 Vocal Jazz**

Girls: a solid black dress (within school guidelines) with black, opaque tights.

Boys: solid black button-up shirt with black buttons.

## **TEXTBOOKS**

Textbooks are assigned to students in each course as required, at which time the condition of the textbooks will be recorded. The textbooks are to be kept at school in the student lockers (unless required for classes and homework) and it will be the student's responsibility to care for these textbooks and have them available for class.
