Kindergarten

Our Kindergarten program fosters a nurturing and inclusive environment where young children are encouraged to explore, learn, and grow through play-based and hands-on experiences. It emphasizes the development of key social, emotional, cognitive, spiritual, and physical skills, with a focus on building a strong foundation for lifelong learning.

The curriculum is balanced and developmentally appropriate, incorporating activities that promote language and literacy, early math concepts, creativity, and problem-solving. The program encourages collaboration, communication, and independence while also supporting each child's individual needs and interests. Teachers provide a safe, stimulating atmosphere where curiosity is nurtured and children develop confidence, resilience, and a love for learning.

BEFORE & AFTER SCHOOL CARE

We recognize parents' work schedules vary, so we offer Before & After School Care (BASC) for students under the age of 12 as an added-value program to support LCS families. This fee-for-service program features a fun and friendly atmosphere, a variety of activities, gym time, and outdoor play.

Middle Years

(GRADES 5 TO 8)

Our LCS Middle Years students are engaged in a caring learning environment where each individual is encouraged as they prepare for Senior Years. Our teachers support students as they learn new concepts, experience challenges, and celebrate success in and out of the classroom.

Academic Program

Our Middle Years program has a strong academic focus, incorporating the full Manitoba curriculum with a biblical worldview woven across all subject areas. Our instruction emphasizes literacy, reading comprehension, critical thinking skills, and project-based learning while encouraging students to foster strategic thinking and analytical skills in preparation for Senior Years.

Music

The Middle Years music program builds upon the solid foundation students learn in Early Years. With band starting in Grade 6, students are encouraged to develop their musical gifts. Performance opportunities allow students to develop confidence and are an important part of our program.

Athletics

Our athletics program emphasizes the importance of teamwork. Students develop their athletic skills while learning leadership, sportsmanship, and resilience. Competitive athletics opportunities begin in Grade 7.

Outreach, Enrichment & Extracurricular

At LCS, we encourage enriching learning activities within the classroom, guided by our dedicated teachers. Enrichment and a wide variety of co-curriculars work hand in hand with the academic curriculum to foster learning, team building, commitment, and character development while building community. The Science Fair, The World Vision Outreach Challenge, and speech and math contests are among the highly anticipated activities held annually for our Middle Years students.

In Senior Years, students are prepared for life beyond high school. Our LCS grads are well equipped for post-secondary education, adulthood, and active engagement in the community. Academic Program

Our Senior Years program offers access to more than 90 different courses that meet the Manitoba curriculum. We promote a high standard of academic achievement based on the characteristics and potential of each individual student.

Performing & Visual Arts

Our Senior Years students have options to participate in band, choral music, jazz band, vocal jazz, and much more — with concerts, chapels, and festival performances. Drama and Visual Arts provide additional opportunities for students to use their creative talents.

Athletics

Senior Years students have opportunities to play competitive sports on over 20 different teams, where they develop skills in leadership, sportsmanship, and resilience. We also offer Basketball, Volleyball, and Fitness Academies for skill building in Grades 11 and 12.

Co-curricular Activities

We offer a variety of opportunities in the arts, clubs, school leadership, service, Bible studies, intramural and team sports, and recreational activities. These are aimed at enriching the LCS experience, building a strong community, and fostering growth in learning, teamwork, commitment, and character development.

University and Career Counselling

As students move towards graduation, our University and Career Counsellor provides guidance on admissions requirements for university and college programs, application assistance, available scholarships, and career exploration.

Performing Arts

The Performing Arts program at LCS serves as a vibrant expression of faith, creativity, and community. Through band, choir, jazz band, vocal jazz, vocal ensemble, and drama, we provide students with the opportunity to develop their talents while reflecting Christian values of excellence, integrity, and service. Our programs encourage artistic growth, develop character, and promote collaboration, all within a Christ-centred community. The Arts are an integral part of our school, allowing students to explore their gifts, inspire others, and contribute meaningfully in church, school, and the world.

Our bands and choirs are recognized for an exceptionally high-performance standard and frequently perform in festivals and at special events.



Visual Arts

LCS students participate in Visual Arts education throughout their education, beginning with in-classroom activities in Early Years, class courses in Middle Years, and elective choices in Senior Years. Through sculpture, sketching, painting, ceramics, and other mediums, students are inspired to express themselves creatively while developing their skills.

School of Fine Arts

The School of Fine Arts (SOFA) is an added-value program at LCS that offers in-person, private music instruction from gifted, passionate, and experienced Christian teachers. Lessons take place on site before, during, or at the end of the school day. SOFA also offers group lessons in Introduction to Musical Theatre and Art.
